OUTLINE OF PROGRAM: Students will be grouped by age, evaluated by our staff and then regrouped based on their ability level. The daily instructional program will stress the fundamentals of hitting, throwing, fielding and base stealing. Players will select and take part in a daily position workshop. Emphasis will be in the areas of pitching, infield and catching. Once again, we will include clinics on proper speed development. Students will participate daily in instructional games. Coaching will stress defensive play with emphasis on team effort.
